Docking palettes in QuarkXPress. You can dock a palette or palette group to the left or right edge of your display by dragging it until a blue area appears around it. When you release the mouse, that palette (or palette group) positions itself in the optimum location against that edge. This docking feature also makes palette hiding possible.

As shown in the image below, simply go to the directory with your blocks, right-click, and choose create tool palette. As you get more familiar with creating tool palettes, they can also be customized and grouped, giving you even more flexibility.

Call CControlBar::EnableDocking for each toolbar you want to dock, specifying the destination sides to which the toolbar should dock. If none of the sides specified in the call to CControlBar::EnableDocking match the sides enabled for docking in the frame window, the toolbar cannot dock — it will float. Once it has been floated, it remains a floating toolbar, unable to dock to the frame window.

You can create a dock by moving panels to the right edge of the workspace until a drop zone appears. To remove a panel, right-click (Windows) or Control-click (Mac) its tab and then select Close, or deselect it from the Window menu. To add a panel, select it from the Window menu and dock it wherever you want.

How to customize the Illustrator workspace

Drag the palette's title bar to a new position. To dock a floating palette: Do one of the following: Double-click the palette's title bar. Drag the palette's title bar to a margin of the graphics area. Right-click the Auto-Hide button and click Dock Left or Dock Right. Right-click the Auto-Hide button and click Dock Left or Dock Right.

Palettes are a list or grouping of commands or information which will allow you to edit your images. Some palettes are not visible when you open PaintShop Pro while others are. I can make it snap to position in a corner, but it doesn't dock and doesn't stop floating. It's not just the inconsistency and nuisance of it sitting on top of the documents and not moving with the rest of the window that causes a problem: I'm on a Mac (Lion) and the floating toolbar breaks a normal useful operating system function.
