Singular and Plural Nouns. The difference between singular and plural nouns is easy to spot. When a noun indicates one only, it is a singular noun. When a noun indicates more than one, it is plural. Singular Noun Examples. The following sentences contain singular nouns examples. The boy had a baseball in his hand. My horse prefers to wear an English saddle.

### Singular & Plural Nouns | Definition, Examples & Exercises

Regular nouns. Most singular nouns form the plural by adding -s. A singular noun ending in s, x, z, ch, sh makes the plural by adding -es. A singular noun ending in a consonant and then y makes the plural by dropping the y and adding -ies.

### Singular and plural nouns - EF

Singular Form. When a noun is singular, it means there is one of them. For Example: Dog, balloon, toy, friend, house, family, elephant etc. Plural Form. When a noun is plural it means there is more than one. To make most nouns plural we simply add -s. There are many irregular nouns that add es. For Example: Dogs, balloons, toys, friends, houses, families, elephants etc.

### Singular and Plural Forms of the Nouns | English, Grammar

Singular nouns that end in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch', 'sh', or 'ss', form the plural by adding -es. For Examples: bus - buses. bench - benches. box - boxes. dish - dishes. truss - trusses. marsh - marshes. lunch - lunches.
